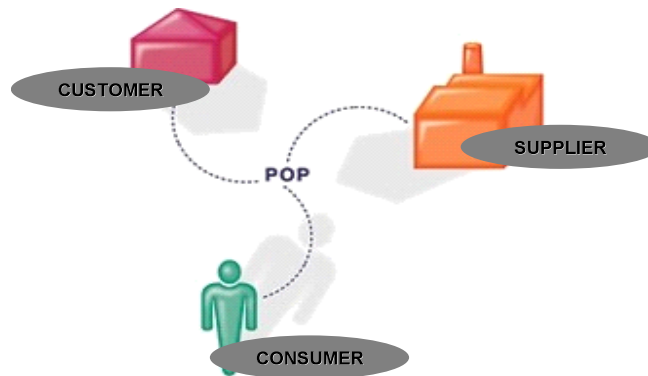


## Getting Ready For GSCOP – Workshop Overview
